General Traffic Equipment's 12 and 18 circuit DISCONNECT HANGERS take the place of conventional wire entrance heads for signals suspended from span wire or mast arms. The DISCONNECT HANGER allows the user to connect signals without the use of splices and remove the signals in the future by just pulling a plug! This is an invaluable aid for cleaning and repainting weather-beaten signals. The DISCONNECT HANGER consists of a Ductile Iron balance adjuster, cast body with 210° swing out door, your choice of either a tri-stud or 1 1/2" threaded bottom adaptor hub, and a wiring harness and connector for signal wiring. The same housing is used for both 12 and 18 circuit hangers which eliminates stocking replacement doors, hardware, etc. for two different types. The housing body is cast from aluminum alloy 356-T6 for extra strength. All hardware is stainless steel for corrosion resistance. Compression style terminal blocks allow for crimp-free field wiring!
